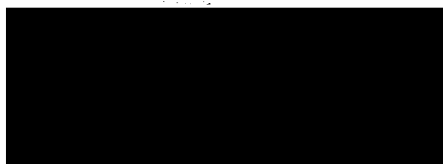

7. The Hua Nan (華南) Auto Company⁸, fourth floor, 5 Des Voeux Road is a Chinese Communist espionage center and a purchasing station for war materials for Communist China.
8. The Nan Hua (南華) Manufacturing Company⁹ of Hong Kong has received an order for 500 junk engines and 500 automobile engines from the Chinese Communists.
- 25X1A 1. Comment. The Vietnamese equivalent is Truong Di Dan.
- 25X1A 2. Comment. Presumably this would be the Great China Hotel, 119 Connaught Road, Central.
- 25X1A 3. Comment. According to information available to this office, OU-YANG Shan has previously held positions as a member of the Culture and Education Committee for Central and South China and as chief of the Canton branch of the Sino-Soviet Friendship Association.
- 25X1A 4. Comment. According to CHUANG has previously held important positions in Chinese Communist military missions to the DRV. 25X1A
- 25X1A 5. Comment. According to information available to this office, FEI Hsiao-tung, a prominent Chinese anthropologist, has previously been employed by the Chinese Communists as an emissary to the YAO people of Kwangsi. The assignment here reported may be a similar one.
- 25X1A 6. Comment. In Hong Kong, such a name would probably be rendered Man Yik.
- 25X1A 7. Comment. According to information available to this office, CH'EN was active in April 1951 in the Hua Ch'iao or Overseas Chinese Trading Company. This company was engaged in procurement of material for the Chinese Communists and cornering foreign exchange.
- 25X1A 8. Comment. Presumably this is Hua Nan Motors, Fed. Inc. U.S.A., of the same address, who are authorized dealers for De Soto automobiles in Hong Kong. Hua Nan Motors is a subsidiary of the Union Investment Company of Hong Kong.
- 25X1A 9. Comment. This may be the Nan Hua Ironworks, reported in as supplying Diesel engines for junks being fitted at Whampoa. 25X1A
