SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

1. The automobile repair shop of the Federal Construction Ministry is located in Belgrade Narodnog Fronta Street (the former Kraljice Natalije Street) nr. 88, on the first floor of a five-story building, which was formerly the Srbija garage owned by Danilo Zlatic. Nationalized in 1948, it has become the automobile repair shop of the Federal Construction Ministry. The Chief of the shop is Engineer Ignjatovic.
2. The shop employs about 10 mechanics, aided by a number of assistants and apprentices. The total number of employees is about 50. The chief duty of the shop is the repair of all automobiles and trucks of the Construction Ministry as well as those belonging to the enterprises in Belgrade subordinated to the shop itself. The shop also repairs trucks arriving from the interior of Yugoslavia on official errands.
3. Some engineers and technicians are called in to help occasionally when certain more complicated repairs are involved. These men regularly work in the Communications Sections of the Federal Construction Ministry, which is located near the repair shop on the corner of Kneza Milosa and Masarikova Streets.
4. The repair shop is equipped with:
 - 2 carpenter's benches
 - 2 grinding machines, one hand-driven and the other electric.

The shop is also equipped with all the other modern devices necessary to an automobile repair shop. An average of 20 general rotor repairs to cars or trucks are made each month.
5. Some minor spare parts are manufactured by the shop but the more complex parts are ordered from Italy. Spare part orders are placed by the chief of the shop, Engineer Ignjatovic, who often travels abroad. When he is absent, he is represented by Josip Kocisevic, who serves in the Communications Section of the Federal Construction Ministry.
