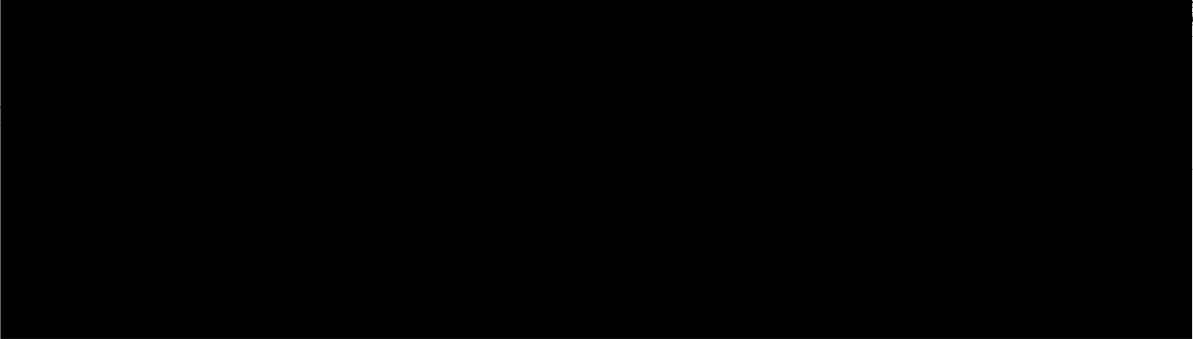

On 20 April a meeting was held in the Sino-Soviet Joint Aid Commission, Peiping, at which the following resolutions were adopted:

- a. Rumors that the American imperialists will effect the occupation of Taiwan and that the Military Assistance Advisory Group on Taiwan will keep a close watch on the Nationalist Government will be disseminated to increase anti-American sentiment.
- b. The Kwangtung Government will conduct an anti-British movement in condemning Britain's occupation of Hong Kong. Schools and social bodies will intensify "Liberation and recovery of Hong Kong" campaigns.
- c. To prepare against a possible Nationalist counter-offensive with American aid against South China and Nationalist air bombardment of railroads, all provincial authorities in South China will be asked to build more highways as soon as possible.
- d. Soviet military advisers believe that the United States will eventually support the Nationalist in launching a counter-offensive against South China sometime this autumn. Attention of the Central and South China authorities would be called to this and coastal defense strength of South China should be stepped up. More land and air forces should be sent southward to bolster the defense of South China.
