### North River District Column

The 1 and 4 Sub-Columns under HO Chi-lin and HUANG Chieng-chen have been dissolved because of their laziness and poor achievements.

Units under HUANO Chiang (黄 硷), CHANG Hsiung (暖 雄) and LIANG Wei (泉 威) have been organized as the I Sub-Column with HUANG Hua (黄 華) as commander.

A unit under MIEH Wei-min (謝 偉氏) has been formed as the 4 Sub-Column.

The 2 and 3 Sub-Columns and the Independent Battalion under TSAO Tieh-feng, LI Yao and YU I-fan have been combined into the 2 Sub-Column under YU I-fan.

The 5 Sub-Column and a unit under LIN Cho-hua (林 卓華) have been combined into the 3 Sub-Column with LIN Cho-hua as commander.

As of 26 July, the column was composed of h,509 mon, equipped with 7 mortars, 15 heavy machine guns, 37 light machine guns, 3.779 ridles, \$60 pistols, 13 granade launchers, and 575 hand granades. The column is now training its military and political staffs in small group meetings.

#### West River District Column

The achievement of this column has been limited because of a shortage in ammunition and lack of unified action and political aims. Since July its military and political statis have undergone training and are being sent to various bases to assist in the organization of local people. The staffs are also advising on the policies and tectics of the sub-columns.

#### Kuang-San District Column

I Sub-Column CHUN Teng-ta Is expending its force towards the Kwangtung-Kiangsi border.

2 Sub-Column CHANG Ta-chieh Is organizing the local people at Tashuikang (大 成 尚) and is arranging

liaison with the 1 and 3 Sub-Columns.

3 Sub-Column HOW Kinci-lin Has established a base in Heitineshan. (黑頂山) and is expanding its force

in Yulao (漁榜) and Motorum(112-32, 22-58).

## Coastal District Column

## Southern Fulden District Column

1 Sub-Colu n

CIVAG Chen-lung

Was totally consisted by 6,000 Communist troops between Checan (117-12, 23-44) and Yunksiao(117-15, 24-01) on 23 June. CUMNO and the communders of the 1 and 2 Rattalion were captured by the Communists. The 3 Rattalion commander CHUM Kuan-yao (深 ) escaped to Chinmon (全 吗).

The 2 and 3 Sub-Columns have buried their weapons and have dispersed their men because of extreme Communist pressure.

### Wostern Fulden District Column

1 Sub-Column. CHUNG Hsi-chiao Has been transferred to the Kwangtung-Kiangsi-Fukien Border Listrict Column.

2 Sub-Column LAN Totui-ying Was reorganized as the 1 Sub-Column and is in the Shanghang (116-27,05-02) area.

3 Sub-Column LO Hung-chi Was reorganized as the 2 Euro-Column and is in the Lungyen (117-02, 25-07)

and Yingshih(應点) area.

4 Sub-Column HSICH Kuang-hsun Tas reorganized as the 3 Sub-Column and is in the Taoyuanshan ( ) H 14

area.

#### Kwangtung-Kiangsi-Fukien Border District Column

1 Sub-Column LI Shao-ju

Has been replaced by the 1 Cub-Column of the Mestern Fukien District Column under CHUMO Hsi-chiao. LI who is lazy and shiftless has been suspended.

Three units under CHUNG Hsi-chizo, LO Pei-sheng, and CHANG Te-ts' in (最後) have been reorganized as the 3 Sub-Column.

#### Kwangtung-Hunan Border District Column

This column has been active in the organization of local people. It has also taken steps to contact the Central Hunan Column under LIU Kuang-hoi (制 廣 論) and forces in Lien Hsien (112-26, 2h-h7) and Lienston (112-1h, 2h-hh).

# Kwangtung-Kiangsi Border District Column

This column was formed in J ly and is composed of 3,600 men with 2,970 rifles.

2. On 2 August guerrilla troops under HCU Pang (M. M.) attacked the railroad station at Hainjermino (44 A. M.) and burned two cars of gaseline, Milled over ten Communist troops of the Fallroad G ord Legiment, and captured seven rifles. The guerrillas did not suffer any losses.

- 3. On 20 August a guerrilla offersive was launched on the Chiangchiang (10, 11) Police Station in Jenhua (113-hh, 25-06) in which the station chief and ten policemen were killed and three policemen ceptured. The guerrillas released over ten landlores who had been imprisioned by the Communists. Two guerrillas were wounded in the battle.
- 4. On 2 August guerrilla troops under YIMI Chao (2 12) attacked a summer harvest taxation team at Chachi (114-12, 24-34) and inflicted over ten Communist casualties and captured five rifles. On 19 August the men occupied Nanhua (4 2) Temple after a three heur fight with the Communists. Over 300 imprisoned lendlords were released and a Communist battalien commander and 20 soldiers were killed. The Communist 11 Public Security Regiment at Mapa (4 12) arrived to reinforce the troops at the tample, and six guerrillas were wounded by them when retreating to Huangtung (114-14, 24-58).
- 5. On 21 August a guerrilla unit under LI Chih-chao (李 t t ) ambushed a Communist battalion of the 459 Regiment at Huangkeng (115-26, 24-32). Three hundred men who were concentrated in Plotiou (我 ) ambushed the Communist vanguard who lost ten men and fled in confusion. Then the main Communist force arrived the following merning, the guerrillas had escaped to the Leiyaoshan (素 ) area with two captured sub-machine mass.
- 6. On 15 June the 3 Sub-Column, Fukien-Kwangtung Border District Column, under CH'FN T'ien-jung (於人 ) began attacks against Communist village offices at T'aoyuan (東京 ) and Huangsha (東京), Kwangtung. They billed 3 Communist troops, captured 2 rifles, 1 pistol and 4 hend grandes, and distributed food to the local people.
- 8. The Han River Column under CHT G Yung (於 ) and a battalion under CHUNG Kuo-haun (就 減 数 ) have started propagands campaigns in the Chiaoling (116-10, 24-60) area.
- 9. In late July the Changhang Column under HBAKG Hai-shan (東京) noved toward Tungkuchang (公文文章) and Fenghuangsian (文文章). In 25 July a Communist militia company in Pingts un (公文章) attacked the guerrillas at Chihshibhsiang (本文文章). Two of the guerrillas were wounded while the Communists lost four men.
- 10. The 2 Sub-Column under TU K'o-kang (是 复词) of the Kwangtung-Kiangsi Column has moved to Wuch'inchang (海 海崎).
