The following are research institutes in Rostock:

1. University Children's Hospital. One official research assignment on infant diseases caused either directly by bac coli(sic) or appearing in connection with certain groups of coli bacilli is being carried on. The chief, Dr. Schmidt, states that the hospital does not wish to accept any further official research assignments, because this type of research is not desirable in his institute.
2. University Polyclinic. The chief of the polyclinic, Professor Maack, states that he desires to work on the following two problems: Influence of high frequency and ultrasound on several diseases with special observation of capillars and the biology of leukocyte. For both research purposes there is a complete lack of technical and optical knowledge. The specialist on leukocyte refuses all information on her research.
3. University hospital for nervous disorders, Gelsheim. The hospital chief, Dr. Goellnitz, is making tests of the reactions of normal and sick children and is also engaged in tests of X-ray pictures of the human brain, taken at short intervals from two directions. No official research assignments have been given this hospital.
4. University Hygienic Institute. Its chief, is Professor Johannes Kathe. The institute is engaged in the following three research tasks:
 - a. Leptospira. The research is carried on in the room adjoining to Kathe's office, apparently in his own interest. The laboratory chief is Frau Dr. Enkelmann. Her main work centers around the differential diagnosis of various groups. She is carrying out tests with luminescence for quicker optical proof of causative agents.
 - b. Tests of TB inoculation material in connection with Professor Dr. Hans Knoell's research in Jena.
 - c. Supervision of penicillin production. The material arrives once a week from Jena by special courier.
