SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

- On approximately 8 November 1951, in Pazardzhik, citizens of the town attacked gendarmes and soldiers. The reasons for this attack are not known.
- 2. As of 19 November 1951, travel to and from villages in the Gotse Delchev (Nevrokop) area was prohibited for a period of one month. Identity cards have been collected in the villages south of Gotse Delchev; however, in the town of Gotse Delchev itself, identity cards were not collected, although travel to and from the city was prohibited.
- On 19 November 1951, infantry units arrived in the Gotse Delchev area to reinforce the Border Guards.
