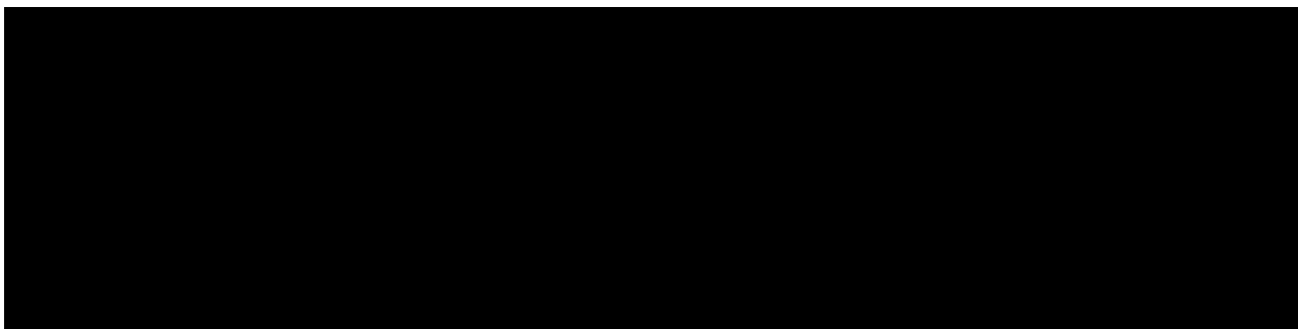

1. The following units of the 24th Air Army were observed flying on 28 November 1951:

- One fighter regiment each at Zerbst and Neubrandenburg.
- Two fighter regiments at Grossenhain.
- One transport regiment at Staaken.
- One bomber regiment at Oranienburg.
- Two bomber regiments at Jüterbog.
- A bomber division headquarters at Jüterbog was also observed.

2. The following units were identified on 29 November:

- One fighter regiment each at Brandenburg-Priest, Parchim, Pütnitz, and Wittstock.
- Two fighter regiments each at Zerbst.
- A fighter division headquarters at Zerbst.
- One bomber regiment at Oranienburg.
- Two bomber regiments at Jüterbog.
- A bomber division headquarters at Jüterbog.

3. Fighter regiments were observed flying on 30 November at Zerbst (two regiments) and at Lärz.

4. On 1 December a bomber regiment at Finsterwalde was observed flying.
