These secretaries are to receive a salary of 50 to 150 yuan 4, paid by the organization in which they work, and are to make a monthly report to the New Memocratic Movement Flanning Committee. The committee planned to liquidate all undesirable persons in each Communist-controlled organization in Macao. It also required that all important accidents be reported to the committee before being reported elsewhere.

- with the establishment of the New Democratic Movement Planning Committee, all Communist-sponsored organizations in Macao were placed under the unitied control of Chimmen. This unit started expanding in January 1951 and by August had more than fifty members, including MAC Ching-wen and Br. hUnd Jung-tseng. The committee has established an investigation team which corperates with Communist agents in Lacac and submits reports to the South China Sub-Bureau through the Chinchiang branch of the Democratic League. The Youth Triendship (Social) Association in Lacac is actually a branch of the Crina Democratic League although it is established branch of the New Democratic League. LU Men-had is chief of the Chungshan Usien police department and lives at the Jardim da Flora, Edcac. SUN is also a member of the New Democratic League and lives on the third floor of the branch office of the Chungshan Ice Flant.
