1. The S.S. RED OCTOBER, a Greek-owned ship of Panamanian registry, which had been surrendered to the Soviets several months are by its crew, was in Constanta herbor in September 1951. The ship had been converted into a floating fish cannery and turned over to the Rumanian Republic.

25X1X 2. the crew, largely Greek nationals, had been imprisoned in Constanta prison for attempting to seize control of the ship while in Turkish waters and bring it back to Greece. The attempt was radiced to Rumanian authorities by the First and Second Empineers of the ship. Emmanian Air Force planes flew to the scene and ordered the crew to bring the ship to Constanta.

3. It was reported that the crew had been disappointed with Communism and had decided to return to Greece.
