1. In the middle of September, 34 Chinese Communist military cadre members headed by YEH Hsun (葉孫) left for Yulin (109-34, 18-13) as directed by the Chinese Communist South China Bureau. They all left Yulin by submarine with 1,000 automatic rifles and other small arms for Indonesia, where they landed secretly on 28 October [REDACTED]. The mission of this group is to assist the Indonesian Communists establish an operations unit. 1

Comment. There have been numerous reports of Soviet and unidentified submarines operating in Southeast Asian waters. [redacted] reported that submarines were seen off the coast of Thailand in October 1950. [redacted] reported that in April 1951 Luis Taruc, HCB leader, and 6 companions were going to Yulin Harbor, Hainan, to board a small Soviet submarine which would take them to the Philippines. [redacted] reported that in mid-April 1951, Soviet submarines, carrying Communist agents, left Yulin Harbor for the Philippines or Malaya. 25X1A

In [redacted] 20 July 1951, a [redacted] USSR submarines were landing Communist agitators in Indonesia in the vicinities of Belawan/Deli, Sumatra, the south coast of East Java, and the Buton area of Celebes. Agents and supplies were picked up in waiting praus or put into inflated rubber rafts and later taken aboard the praus. The [redacted] the same submarines were used to land agents and supplies in the Philippine Islands. 25X1A
