

Between 9 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. about 500 EL and 50 officers were seen walking to the sports field in order to attend the military ceremony. Almost all troops belonging to the march units were young soldiers with closely cropped hair, wearing red-bordered black epaulets and without weapons. Since troops were still observed in the barracks installations the military ceremony, and not take part in it. It was said that a driver training school was located in the Fontane Schule.

2. A column of 20 amphiblous vehicles and 20 motorcycles was seen moving along the road from Neustadt on the Bosse River to Altruppin at 5:30 p.m. on 30 October. A convoy of trucks towing AT guns and artillery pieces and carrying a total of 500 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets, partly with artillery insignia, was seen moving along the road from Neuruppin toward Oranienburg between 8:30 and 12 a.m. The following vehicles were
