- On June 8th of this year, at six o'clock, fire simultaneously broke out at three new, recently drilled petroleum wells. The fire immediately grew and within half an hour six derricks were completely burned. The fire lasted until 5:00 pm when firemen collectives succeeded in localizing it. The plugging of the holes lasted until late into the night.
- 2. The estimated damage exceeds 250 million dinars. Fleven derricks with all drilling equipment were burned, while 6 to 8 drilling rigs were damaged and cannot be used for work at least temporarily.
- 3. A certain Danilov, a Bulgarian who disappeared while the fire was being extinguished, is alleged to be guilty of the sabotage, since the fire broke cut simultaneously in 3 different places, a few hundred meters from each other. The UDB and the National Filitia of Bela Crkva made a very thorough investigation and during the night of 8 and 9 June over 80 workers and employees of the Bela Crkva oilfields were arrested. After 12 hours of interrogation almost all of them were released with the exception of 3 who were detained in prison but whose names are unknown.
- Neither the authorities nor the Yugoslav press made any detailed corment on the case with the exception of a short report that fire broke out on Bela Crkva oilfield and that it had been quickly extinguished due to the selfsacrifice of workers and the people's authorities.
