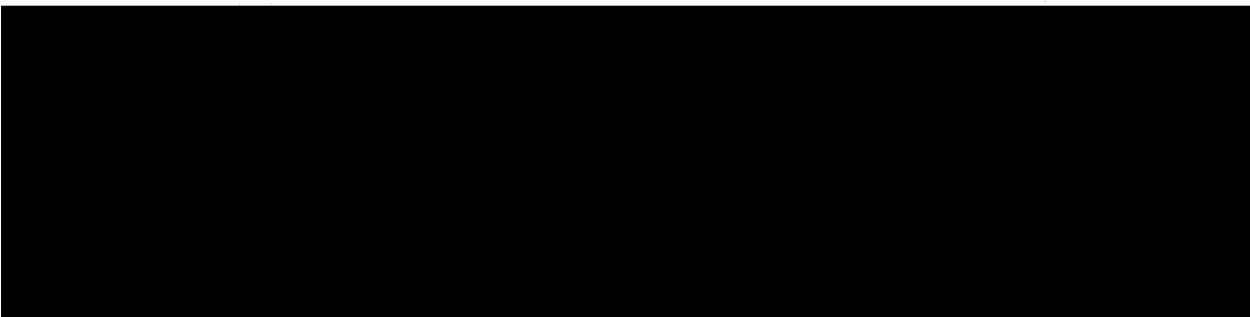

1. On [REDACTED], a new airfield was installed at Parta.
  2. Since 18 October 1950, Soviet type planes (JAK-15) which come crated in large boxes have been unpacked by Rumanian laborers under the supervision of Soviet personnel. They are towed to the Parta airfield by six Zato caterpillar tractors. After the JAK-15's have been assembled they are test flown. Approximately 27 JAK-15's were noted.
  3. About nine LA-7 planes were observed at the Parta airfield. The Sovrommetal firm at Resita installs German type Argus motors in these planes.
