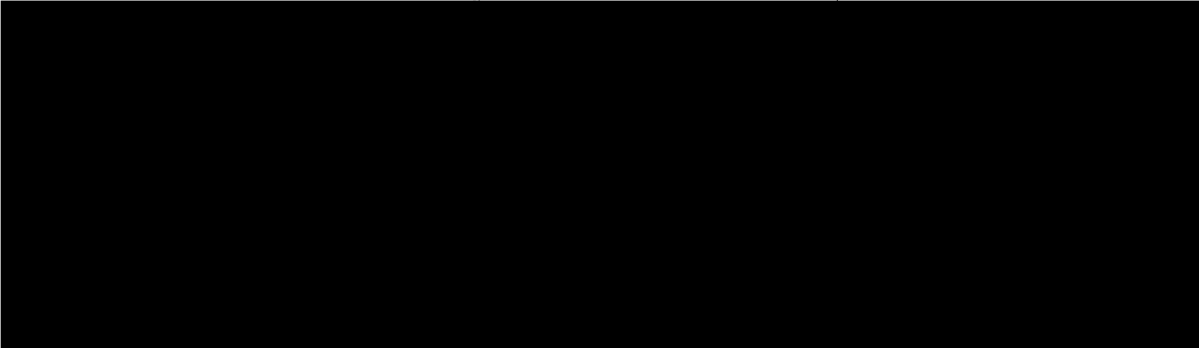

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. In 1950 about 1,500 Moslem male students and about 400 to 500 Moslem female students were being held in the prison of Sarajevo for being members of the Mladi Muslimani Organizacia (Moslem Youth Organization), which has as its goal the overthrow of the present regime in Yugoslavia.
2. In early 1951 in the prison of Skoplje there were persons who had been imprisoned for being members of the following organizations:
 - a. Omladinska Kraljevska Organizacia (OKO; Royalist Youth Organization);
 - b. Revolucionarna Narodna Bulgaria (RNB; Bulgarian Nationalist Revolutionary Organization);
 - c. Guzea, an organization of Yugoslav Moslems which has as its goal the overthrow of the Communist regime;
 - d. Shipetar Demokrati, an organization of Yugoslav Albanians;
 - e. Teva, an organization of Albanian refugees in Yugoslavia which is supported by a certain Teva, a minister during the reign of King Zog, now residing in Italy; and
 - f. Internal Macedonian Revolutionary Organization (IMRO).
