SUBJECT Communist Order of Battle in the Chongju, Kaesong and Namch'onjom Areas

1. Between 14 and 19 November the dispositions of enemy units were as follows:

a. Chongju area (125-13, 39-42) (XD-9096): North Korean 964 Unit of approximately regiment size at T'anu-dong (125-16, 39-47) (XE-9406); North Korean 10 Division Headquarters at Ch'ondae-dong (125-08, 39-36) (XD-8385) with the 25 Regiment of this division reorganizing at Ch'ondae; one battalion of Russian troops with 6 to 10 anti-aircraft pieces and an unknown number of tanks at Pangch'on (125-14, 39-44) (XE-9100); the 308 Unit (sic) of the Chinese Communist 66 Army Supply Headquarters at Yonho-dong (125-28, 39-22) (XD-9278) (sic); the North Korean 10 Evacuation Hospital at T'anu-dong with a staff comprising 8 Rumanian doctors, 3 Soviet army surgeons, and 3 Rumanian female doctors.

b. Kaesong area (126-33, 37-58) (BT-8505): North Korean I Corps Headquarters at Sariwon (125-45, 38-30) (YC-4064); the North Korean 47 and 8 Divisions in the Kaesong area; the Chinese Communist 71, 67, 68, 32, 56, and 63 Divisions¹ moving from the Sinmak (126-14, 38-25) (BT-5855) area to west of Ch'orwon (127-12, 38-15) (CT-4335).

c. Namch'onjom area (126-24, 38-20) (BT-7346): Five Chinese Communist divisions, which were reorganized north of P'yongyang, arrived in the Namch'on-koksan (126-40, 38-47) (BT-9795) area about 3 November. Extensive road and bridge repairs have been made in the area.

2. In mid-November a Russian air force radar unit was in Sariwon. The unit comprises 1 Russian lieutenant colonel, 2 captains, and 200 troops. The North Korean I Corps Guard Company was attached as a security guard for the unit. All Russian officers and men of this unit wear Russian uniforms and state openly that they are members of Russian advisory groups. Other Soviet anti-air units were reported in the area between Namch'on and Kaesong.

1. [REDACTED] Comment. According to information available to this office as of 1 October, the Chinese Communist 67 and 68 Divisions of the 23 Army were reported in Chekiang; the 56 Division of the 19 Army was reported in Shensi; the 63 Division of the 21 Army was reported in Chekiang.
