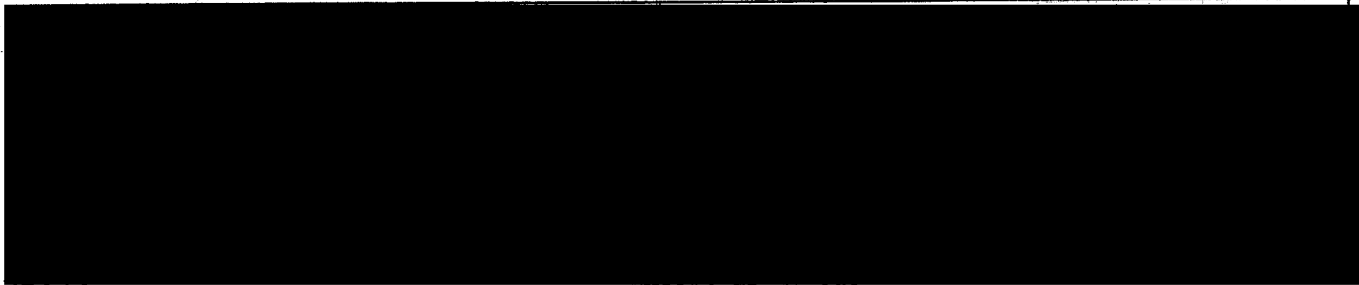

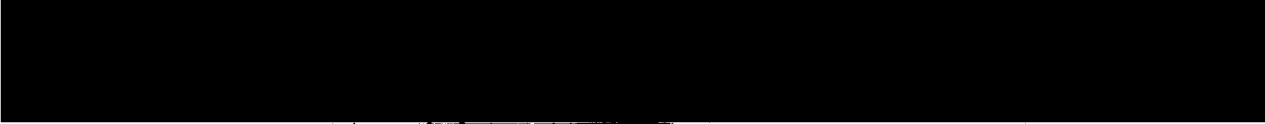

- 1 [REDACTED] Comment. Previous identifications of some of the persons reported are as follows:

CH'EN Chih-fang : Previously reported as acting secretary general of the Canton government in December 1949.

CH'EN I-lin : Previously reported as assistant to the secretary general of the All-China Federation of Literary and Art Workers.

CHENG Shao-k'ang : According to information available to this office, chairman of the Chungshan Military Control Commission and reported to be criticizing the hsien magistrate in June 1951.

CHU Kuang : deputy mayor of Canton and reported to be on bad terms with YEH Chien-ying in mid-1951, according to [REDACTED]

CHUANG Li-hsin : Previously reported as chief of the Taxation Department of the Canton Military Control Committee. 25X1A

CHUNG Chung : Previously reported as member of the standing committee of the Educational Society of the Pearl River District.

CHUNG Fei : Previously reported as deputy chief of the Enemy Property Liquidation Bureau of the Canton government.

FAN Kuo-hua : Previously reported as deputy chief of the Sanitation Department of the Canton government.

FANG Ch'ün-ying : a female cousin of FANG Fang, according to one report.

HO Shu-jen : Previously reported as deputy chief of the Industry and Commerce Department of the Canton government.

HSIAO Kuei-chang : Previously reported as vice chairman of the Canton Chinese People's World Peace and Anti-American Imperialism Committee.

HUANG Ming-ta : Previously reported as deputy chief of the Education Department of the Canton government.

HUANG K'an : possibly the same person reported to have fled to Hong Kong in May 1950 because of financial difficulties in Canton, where he was reorganizing hotel workers' unions.

HUANG Shih-min : director of the Whampoa Harbor Construction Administration Department, according to [REDACTED] 25X1A

KU Kuan-hsien : Previously reported as chief of the Civil Affairs Department of the Canton government.

- LI Chieh-chih : According to information available to this office, sent to Hong Kong by the Chinese Communists in April 1950 to promote the sale of victory bonds. He was reported under Communist surveillance in early 1950.
 - LI Kuo : Previously reported as deputy chief of the Labor Department of the Canton government.
 - LI Ta-ch'ao : Previously reported as chief of the Sanitation Department of the Canton government.
 - LIANG Hsiang : deputy chief of the Canton government's Industry and Commerce Department in June 1951, according to one report.
 - LIANG Kuang : According to information available to this office, deputy mayor of Canton in late 1949. In mid-1951 he was head of the City and Village Relations Committee in Canton, the duty of which was to arrest landlords and others who had fled to Canton to escape arrest in their native places.
 - LIN Ch'uan : Also known as MA Ling, (see below).
 - LIN Hung : Previously reported as deputy director of the Food Department of the Special Administrative Commissioner's Office of the Pearl River District.
 - LIN Lang-t'ien : Previously reported as manager of the People's Bank in Canton.
 - MA Ling : Also known as LIN Ch'uan; According to information available to this office head of the Special Commissioner's Office in Macao, which is responsible for passing orders from the Chinese Communist Party to its subordinate branches in Macao.
 - TAI Tzu-liang : Previously reported as a member of the Kwangtung branch of the China Democratic League.
 - T'AN Kuei-ming : magistrate of Chungshan Hsien and under surveillance by the Communists because of the defection of his friend, LIANG Kuan, according to SO-72650.
 - TENG K'ien : Previously reported as chief of the Engineering Department of the Canton government.
 - TSENG Sheng : head of the Kwangtung River Defense Headquarters, according to [redacted] 25X1A
