8,000 to 10,000 Soviets working in three shifts (Soviet statements).

- 2. Production:
 - a. About 80 electric motors, 60 cm in diameter, per shift.
 - b. Crankshafts 60 cm long for two or three-cylinder engines.
 - c. Straight shafts, 4 to 5 cm in diameter and about 2 to 2.5 meters long (color of shafts: a silvery blue).
- 3. Test stands for aircraft engines:

A test stand was put into operation in mid -1948. The engines produced a howing tone with assumed an ever higher pitch.
