1. A Russian committee of seven experts arrived in East Berlin to study the possibility of installing new radio jamming stations on East German territory. Similar stations are to be erected in Czechoslovakia.

2. A broadcasting station is to be installed in a building now under construction. The present plans provide for a 60 kilowatt station. Should this station be put up, it will be Europe's most powerful transmitter. The Russians hope to put it in operation in January 1952.
