



- 1. An unidentified aircraft, coming from the south, is reported to have flown over Tirana during the course of Red Army Day celebrations on 7 November 1951; the aircraft was shot down after ten minutes of antiaircraft fire.
- 2. On the afternoon of 20 November 1951, an extremely fast piston-engine Soviet fighter plane was observed at Tirana flying at an altitude of not more than 1,000 meters.
