1. [REDACTED] four-engine bombers were over Sinuiju. [REDACTED] 20 four-engine bombers landed at Langtou Airfield, southwest of Antung. These bombers were grey-black in color and had Chinese Communist Air Force markings. Soviet pilots and ground crews were observed checking the bomber equipment.
2. [REDACTED] approximately 50 Soviet pilots were receiving instructions from a Soviet Air Force officer at a briefing map set up in front of billeting tents at the eastern end of Langtou Airfield. At the same time approximately 100 MIG-15's were lined up along the runway approaches and 7 MIG's were patrolling the area.
3. [REDACTED] numerous MIG-15's have been landed at Langtou Airfield and taken immediately to "hill hangars". One observer estimates that 400 MIG's were at this field [REDACTED] Recently, eight Japanese pilots were observed conversing with two Japanese-speaking Soviet pilots at Langtou.
