On 20 October 1952, about 100 civilian laborers were employed at Wielzow airfield. About 40 were working on the construction site adjacent to the east end of the runway. [REDACTED] 50 to 60 Soviet soldiers wearing black-bordered blue epaulets were observed in the area of the low wooden buildings. Eighteen Soviet Air Force soldiers were probably collecting small stones in the area north and west of the runway. Warning signs indicated that a wide strip around the airfield was off limits. [REDACTED] the impression that the field would soon be occupied and put in operation. *
