- The "Tempo" Military Construction Enterprise in Zagreb, which is under the control and supervision of the General Directorate of the Ships Boiler Industry, is reported to be erecting a large, new factory in Samobor, near Zagreb. This new factory will allegedly produce diesel engines for the Yugoslav Navy and will be called the Vladimir Bakaric Diesel Engine Factory. According to source, as soon as the new factory has been completed, the diesel engine construction department at the Aleksander Rankovic Factory in Rijeka will be transferred to the factory in Samobor.
 - The Director of the Vladimir Bakaric Diesel Engine Factory will reportedly be Colonel Zlatko Kerekovic, a former cavalry officer and Ustasha officer in Croatia during World War II. Kerekovic is allegedly an opportunist, of no particular political affiliation. The Commercial Director will reportedly be a former officer named Bozo Cubrikovic, who had served with Yugoslav mountain troops.

- Comment: [REDACTED] reported that a new marine diesel engine factory was under construction near Bregana and Samobor in Croatia. This factory is possibly identical with the Vladimir Bakaric Diesel Engine Factory at Samobor.
