

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.

On 26 September h high-ranking Soviet Army officers and 3 Soviet civilians, believed to be correspondents, arrived at Yonp'o Airfield (127-31, 39-47) (CV-730h) and stayed in Hawhung 3 days before going to Plyongyang. One of the officers was said to be Malinovsky, Commander of Soviet forces in the Far East, and the purpose of his visit was to meet the Chinese and North Korean representatives at the cease-fire talks. It was rumored that the Soviets said a cease-fire would be established, possibly for a short time only, and that the Soviets' purpose was to allow time for the strengthening of Communist forces in Korea.
