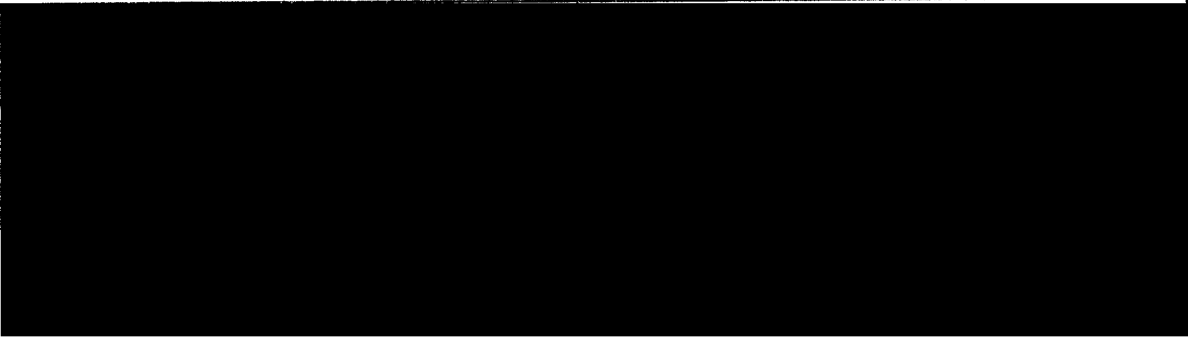

SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. One hundred Air Force supervisors, 600 conscripted Chinese laborers and 60 Soviet trucks with bumpers marked "Tatungkou Haiyun" are engaged in construction of an airfield two miles northeast of Takushan (123-37, 39-53). Work was started April 1951. Laborers are paid JWP 10,000 per day.
2. There are 40 Soviet MIG's, 40 Korean pilots and 40 U-shaped underground hangars at an airfield five miles north of Tatungkou (124-10, 39-52). The field is guarded by Chinese Communist troops equipped with Soviet rifles. There are 100 Soviet troops housed there. A railroad from the airfield to Santoulantou, seven miles south of Antung, was completed July 1951. Sixteen well-camouflaged Soviet anti-aircraft guns are in the hills surrounding the airfield.
