




A total of 10,000 tons of wheat was scheduled to be imported from Hungary during the second half of August 1951. Of this quantity, 8,000 tons were distributed by the VVEAB Erfassungs- und Aufkaufbetriebe für landwirtschafte liche Ergeugnisse, ABR (Association of peoples's owned control and procurement concerns for agricultural products, institution chartered by public law), Berlin-Karlshorst, Gundelfingerstrasse 1, as follows:

- 1. 3,000 tons to VVEAB Potsdam.
- 2. 2,000 tons to VVEAB Brandenburg.
- 3. 1,500 tons to WEAB Fuerstenberg/Havel.
- 4. 500 tons to VVEAB Oranienburg.
- 5. 500 tons to VVEAB Wustrau.
- 6. 500 tons to VVEAB Wittenberge. \*

Comment. The wheat was shipped from Hungary to the harbor of Dresden-Friedrichstadt by rail. From there, 8,000 tons were shipped by water and 2,000 tons by rail.
