Subject: Wheat from Hungary.

We were notified by the VVEAB office at 1 Gundelfingerstrasse in Berlin-Karlshorst that 10,000 tons of wheat from Hungary, which had been previously mentioned, will be imported during the second half of August. We also received instruction that 8,000 tons of this shipment was to be distributed as follows:

1. 3,000 tons to VVEAB Potsdam.
2. 2,000 tons to VVEAB Brandenburg.
3. 1,500 tons to VVEAB Fuerstenberg/Havel.
4. 500 tons to VVEAB Oranienburg.
5. 500 tons to VVEAB Wustrau.
6. 500 tons to VVEAB Wittenberge.

The VVEAB plans to employ the Emil Mueller firm in Dresden for the trans-shipment of this consignment and gave orders that 2 barges per day be shipped to VVEAB Potsdam and VVEAB Brandenburg, 1 barge per day to VVEAB Fuerstenberg/Havel and VVEAB Wustrau and 1 barge each to VVEAB Oranienburg and VVEAB Wittenberge.

We shall inform you by telephone when the shipments start in Hungary and arrive at the border stations. May we ask you to make all necessary preparations to insure a smooth dispatch.
