The Continental Operations Department (COD) was set up in late 1950 to coordinate Nationalist guerrilla activities on the mainland; it is relatively inexperienced as far as intelligence is concerned. It has no known intelligence system, although it does have a small G-2 section. Technically under the Ministry of National Defense (MND), the COD has a degree of access to intelligence procured by the MND.
