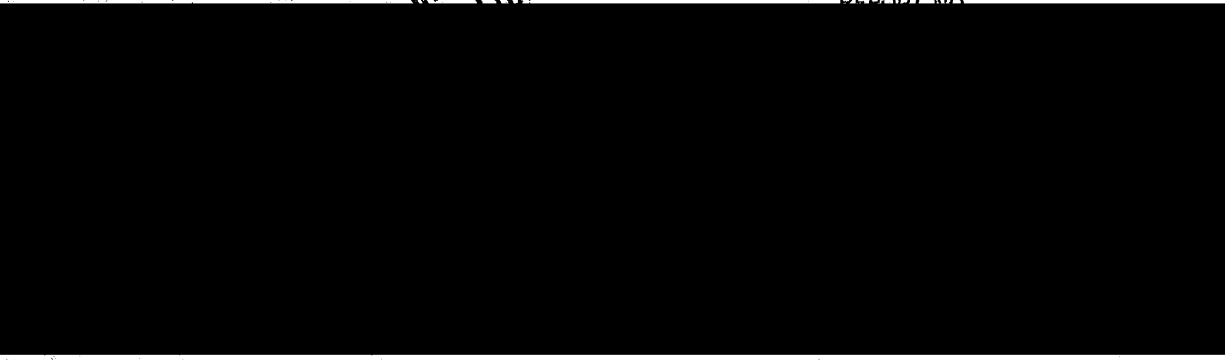

There is much evidence pointing to a general tendency to tighten the rules for inductions for military duty. Lately, university students are being refused deferments. All young men acceptable for military training are subject to three years service. Those whose economic or family background renders them "unfit" for actual duty under arms are inducted for a three year period in special labor battalions. They work either in factories or in State construction projects.
