- On 20 October 1951 KAO Kang, Lihof (利賀夫), Sinkov(辛基夫), and 47 other Soviet advisors left Peiping for Canton to attend a meeting of military and political leaders. In addition to a discussion of aid to the Democratic Republic of Vietnam, Kwangtung defenses, and the return of Hong Kong and Macao to China, it was decided to establish and International Communist Volunteer Headquarters at Nanning and Shench'uan (114-08, 22-32) when the need
- 2. A meeting at Canton on 24 October 1951,2 attended by YEH Chien-ying, KAO Kang, and about 40 other officials, was an annual meeting at which military and political problems were discussed, including Hong Kong and Macao. After the meeting, Soviet advisor Shih-wu-fu-ti (N) (1) 4 (1) dined at the home of YEH Chien-wings The same evening YEH held a small meeting at the Receiving Center, Pai Tzu (百子) Road at which he presented the resolutions of the government concerning an attack on Taiwan. The responsibility of Kwangtung in supplying transportation for troops and supplies was also discussed.
