



SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



- On 8 October 1951, the following arms were shipped through the port of Genoa:
 - a. via Dutch SS BENGKALIS: 746 cases containing 190,000 shells for 20 mm guns. The shells were shipped by the Oerlikon Company of Switzerland to the government of Indonesia.
 - b. via Dutch SS KOTA BAROE: 484 cases containing 124,000 shells for 20 mm guns. This order was also shipped from the Oerlikon Company to the government of Indonesia.
 - c. via Dutch SS KOTA BAROE: 7 cases containing 20 complete 20 mm Oerlikon guns. This order was shipped from the Oerlikon Company to the Kjawatan Kepolisian of Djarkarta, Indonesia.
- The cargoes entered Italy by rail via Chiasso. The Transropa Company, 17 Via Luccioli, were the local agents.
