SUPPLEMENT TO REPORT NO.



1. A second large airfield has been built between Yanglou (116-56, 34-21) and Wanchai (海塘), Kiangsu. The field occupies an area 10 miles wide and 7 miles long. It was completed in the summer of 1951.
2. Kiangwan, Lunghua, and Tachang Airfields, Shanghai, are to be expanded by one-third. There is a total of about 200 planes at these fields; most of the pilots are Soviets.
3. A British model radar station has been set up by the Chinese Communists in the Wanchan Islands (113- , 21-). It has a horizontal search range of 30 knots. A similar station has been erected at Bocca Tiaris.
