## Vessels

The DDR has at its disposal a total of 1500-2000 vessels (prams, tugs, etc.). The prams are divided into two classes:

> "A" - open "B" - covered

The Largest vessels (3der-Mas Kahn) are 1000-1200 Gross Registered Tonnage, and the informant estimates that there are 300-350 of this type. The largest number of prams are 400-600 Gross Registered Tonnage.

About 75% of the vessels are not self-propelled. All prams under 250 tons are self-oropelled. Maximum draft of the prams is 2 meters fully loaded.

It is the responsibility of Arbeitsgemeinschafft Schiffsfahrt to maintain and replace the vessels. For this purpose the Gemeinschaft controls a number of small shipyards (mainly river yards), including the following: Lauenburg, Uckermunde, Anklam and Domnitz.
