Former German general staff officers asserted that in four years at the German military academy they had not been able to assimilate what was taught them in the USSR in fifteen months. During the course, the students were shown many new, still secret. Weapons.

The most important subjects taught were: politics, tactics, deployment of troop units up to army level, partisan combat, assessment of the morale of enemy troop units, assessment of the morale of the population of enemy-occupied territories, propagandizing of enemy troop units, and propagandizing of the population of enemy-occupied territory.
