Zokne Airfield is located about three kilometers southeast of Siauliai, Lithuania (55-54N, 23-22E). The airfield is surrounded by meadows filled with undergrowth. The air eld is of irregular shape, with its dimensions approximately 750 meters by 1 } kilometers. There is no fence around the airfield, but it is encircled by searchlights on posts about three meters high. There are about 40 such lights in all, but all the lights are not illuminated at one time. There are eight hangars on the field, all measuring about 35 to 40 meters long and about 15 meters wide. The height of the hangars is not known. 25X1 The planes were parked, in about two rows, with their tails toward the railroad. Most were twin-engine, but there were some single-engine aircraft. 25X1 An area containing six poles, each about 25 meters high, about a foot in diameter at the bottom, and narrowing at the top, is indicated as Area A on the attached map. Two red lights were visible on each pole - one at the top and one in the center. Wires running (north and south) from one pole to another were visible. Eight or ten circular, hoop-like objects were suspended from each wire. The circular objects were about one meter in diameter and were spaced about one and one-half meters apart. Attachment 2 is a sketch of the appearance of two of the above-mentioned poles and their appurtenances, when looking toward them from the west.
