

Comment:

- a. It is known from other records that some workshops of the DNEPROPATROVSK motor vehicle plant were constructed during the German occupation, but were destroyed with the retreat of German troops. The construction of the new plant on the same site started about early 1945.
- b. This report locates the plant too far south. Other corresponding records report the location two miles south of the town borders. An exact pinpointing of the location was not possible.
- c. The cor-body plant to the south of the motor vehicle plans has not been clarified. the plant the plant had two sections, the main automobile plant and an auxiliary plant, which are about one and a half miles apart. possibly mistook the southern plant for a separate factory.
- d. Additional information is required to clarify location, layout and type of construction of the plant.
