Prior to early July 1951, the old barracks installation in Rasnov (R 35/X 27), consisting of a multiple-story barracks building and several stables, was occupied to capacity by young Rumanian troops on active service. The troops wore olive-drab uniforms and most of them wore their trousers tucked into boots while a few wore wrapped leggings. They wore no berets. Officers wore visor-type caps. they wore red epaulets.
2. Units leaving for field training were repeatedly observed marching toward the mountains. These units had small cannons, drawn by two horses each and mounted on two high wheels. never observed more than three or four of these cannons with a unit.
3. low wooden barracks buildings for military purposes had been constructed in the mountain valleys south of Rasnov in the spring of 1951. No Soviet units or offices were noticed in or near Rasnov.
