1. The barracks installation at the airfield east of Medias (R 36/R 44) which was located between the highway and Tarnava Mare was occupied by Rumanian Air Force troops who wore gray-blue uniforms. Construction was not observed at the field, which appeared to be occupied by biplanes only. Air units, multi-engine aircraft, or parachuting were not observed at the installation which probably was a training field.

2. [Redacted] a Rumanian pilot school was located at the field on the eastern perimeter of Medias. [Redacted] intensive flying by light aircraft at the field. *
