1. On 23 November 1951, six T-34/85 tanks and numerous trucks, [redacted] were observed at the barracks installation on the western side of Hillersleben and in the settlement of Hillersleben. (M 53/Y 51). A radio station with four masts was seen at the southern edge of the billeting area. A radar set was seen at the northern edge of the installation. [redacted] 25X1X

2. The barracks installation on the northeastern side of Hillersleben was occupied by troops who wore red-bordered black epaulets with artillery insignia. Soldiers receiving rifle drill and trucks [redacted] were seen. * 25X1B

25X1A * [redacted] Comment. According to a previous report by the same source, elements of the unidentified AAA regiment and the 62d or 64th Gds Mecz Regt of the 19th Gds Mecz Div have been tentatively carried in the barracks installation on the western side of Hillersleben, and artillery elements of the above mechanized regiment in the installation on the northern side of town. All vehicle

25X1B [redacted] belong to the 19th Gds Mecz Div. The radio station is known from previous reports, whereas the radar set, possibly of Dumbo or RUS/2 type, is reported for the first time.
