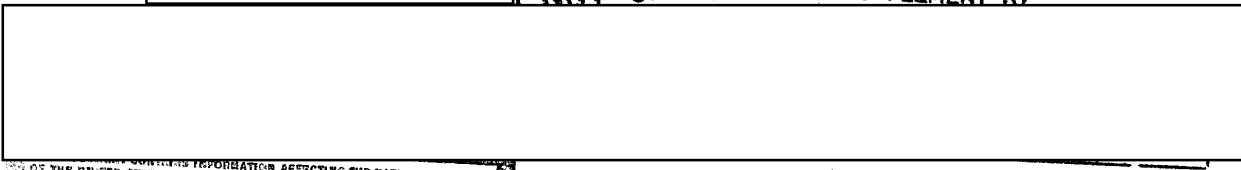

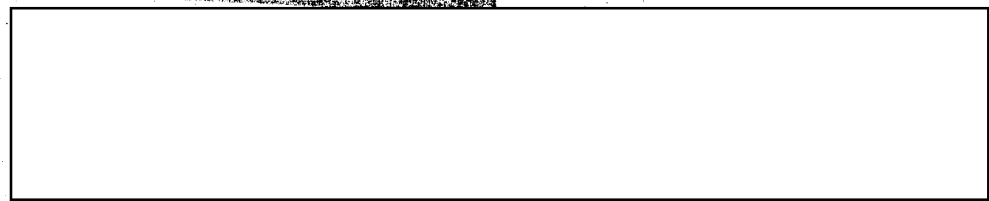

25X1 1. The ninth session of the trial dealt with charges against personnel of the economic and finance sections of the Preparations Committee for the Third World Youth Festival. They revealed considerable information on the financial aspect of the festival.

2. Calculations up to now show that the Third World Youth Festival has cost a total of 760 million east marks. The East Zone government contributed 700 million, while another 140 million were contributed by mass organizations, zone-wide collections and by gifts from the Satellite states. Since a total of 840 million east marks was available, but only 760 million was accounted for, an excess of 80 million should have remained on hand. However, no such funds are known to exist and no records are available which would indicate the whereabouts of such a sum.

3. Inquiries into the expenditures have shown that the following sums were spent by the main departments of the Preparations Committee:

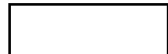
4. The trial further revealed that the Soviet Control Commission, in the name of the Komsovol Central Committee, made available to the Preparations Committee, the sum of 8,500,000 east marks. The records indicate that the money was spent as follows:
