1. Prior to 1 May 1951, all district tobacco directorates were responsible to the Tobacco Directorate in Belgrade. Since that date, however, they have been placed under the jurisdiction of the Central Directorate for War Invalids' Economy of the respective republics' Committee for War Invalids, which in turn is responsible to the Central Directorate of the Yugoslav Central Committee for the Union of War Invalids in Belgrade.
2. The Central Directorate for War Invalids' Economy of the individual republics purchases tobacco from eight different factories located in Banja Luka, Ljubljana, Zagreb, Zadar, Sarajevo, Rovinj, Nis, and Skoplje.
3. The Central Directorate for War Invalids' Economy for the republic of Croatia is located in Zagreb and is under the management of Dinko Kuzmanic, who was formerly director of the Tobacco Directorate in Belgrade. The chief of the commercial section is Ljubo Magjer.
4. The administrative personnel of the Tobacco Directorate at Rijeka, the phone number of which is 40-20, is listed as follows:
 - a. Director: Josip Grzincic, from Klana, who became a partisan in 1941. Although he is a member of the Yugoslav Communist Party, [Redacted]
 - b. Secretary: Viktor Sterpin, a former member of the Croat militia;
 - c. Personnel Manager: Miroslav Skracic, secretary of the Party cell in the Tobacco Directorate, [Redacted]
 - d. Clerk: Antica Dragovic, 18 years of age;
 - e. Commercial Section: Ivan Radotic, former militia officer;
 - f. Tobacco Processing: Edvard Kovacic, a Slovene;
 - g. Statistics: Blanka Baricevic, a student;

5. The personnel employed in the warehouse of the Tobacco Directorate at Rijeka are listed as follows:

a. Manager: Slavko Zivanovic, a Serb, and member of the Party;

b. Administrative officer: Drago Gugic;

c. Treasurer (or cashier): Vanda Fehervari; and

d. Warehouse keepers: Drago Slavic and Andrija Varli.

6. Other warehouses in the Republic of Croatia are located at the following places:

a. Senj, with Plo Loncaric in charge;

b. Crkvenica, with Karlo Birkmajer in charge;

c. Delnice, with Tomo Sunjic in charge;

d. Mali Losinj, with Dinko Muzic in charge;

e. Krk, with Nikola Kraljic in charge;

f. Opatija, with Milan Fratar in charge;

g. Labin, with Anton Faliska in charge;

h. Pulj, with Anton Skoravic in charge;

i. Pazin, with Stjepan Vukovic in charge;

j. Porec, with Peter Mohorovic in charge;

k. Buzet;

l. Rovinj; and

m. Rab.

7. The management board for the Tobacco Directorate at Rijeka is made up of the chairman, Egidio Bratolic; seven tobacco salesmen; and of directors, assistant directors and administrative officers of the individual establishments. The personnel manager must obtain the prior approval of the management board for all new appointments and dismissals. The management board in turn is responsible to the workers' council which is elected by the workers of the respective establishments. The president of the workers' council is Ivo Tomljenovic; Egidio Bratolic is the deputy; and the membership is made up of 15 men who represent tobacco salesmen, administrative officers

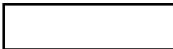

and warehouse keepers. The workers' council usually meets once a month, at which time only minor policy decisions are made, such as reorganization of warehouses; where to purchase office equipment; and so forth. The UDB usually employs tobacco salesmen and warehouse keepers as a means of surveillance over the population.

6. The Tobacco Directorate for the Rijeka district is supplied by various factories with approximately 60,000 kilograms of tobacco every three months.
