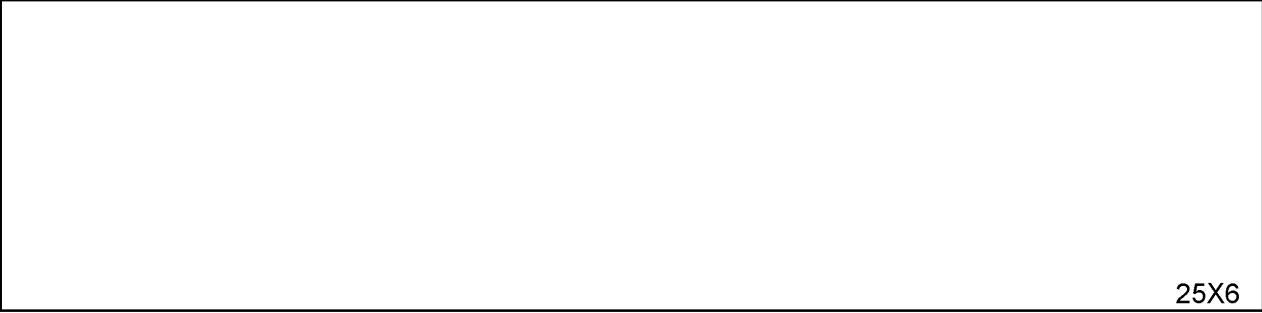

1. In December 1951 [redacted]

[redacted] and several others were trying to raise funds for the publication of a morning or evening newspaper, to follow the same line as the Hsin Wen Pao in Hong Kong. The new publication, to be called the Mac Shih Chieh and appear in February 1952, was to use simple language in setting forth the Chinese Communist policy. [redacted] suggested that they reorganize and expand the Hsin Yuan Ti, published every ten days by the Macao New Democracy Association, into the proposed Mac Shih Chieh.

2. The Chinese Communist New China News Agency was establishing a branch in Macao in house number 2, third floor, Ma Ko, Calçada da Barra.<sup>2</sup> News was to be issued by this branch beginning 1 January 1952. The Communist Ta Chung Pao and the Hua Chiao Jih Pao in Macao use news items issued by the New China News Agency.

2. [redacted] Comment. [redacted] reported the establishment of this office at Calçada da Barra, third floor, and gave more details concerning its organization. Ma Ko appears to refer to a district in Macao where most of the street names include the phrase "da Barra."
