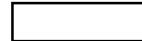
1. On 10 December 1951 the Amoy municipal government opened Highway 304¹ and established check-points along it. All incoming and outgoing seacraft and travelers are also being checked by the harbor police.
2. In order to strengthen precautionary measures against the infiltration of Nationalist agents into Kwangtung, YEH Chien-ying ordered the militia in each hsien to establish check-points for travelers on rivers and highways. Each hsien will be held responsible for damage caused by Nationalist agents who succeed in entering the Hsien. CHUNG Ming-hua (鍾明華) is in charge of these precautions in Central Awangtung, T'IANQ Shao-k'ang (錢少康) in the Pearl River area, and T'IAI Kuo-liang (蔡國樞) in the East River area.
3. A very strict inspection is made of land and water traffic between Macao and Shihch'i at the border station and customhouse at Sanch'ang. Even Chinese Communist party members on official errands are not exempt from being inspected. From Sanch'ang to the Shihch'i Railway Station or to the Shih Wharf, travelers must undergo another inspection.
4. Travelers who go by water from Shihch'i to Canton must pass through the following four check-points:
 - a. T'ien Tzu (天字) Wharf in Shihch'i.

5. Travelers who go by land from Shihch'i to Canton must pass through the following five check-points:
- a. Shihch'i Railway Station.
 - b. Hsiaolan (113-14, 22-40) Railway Station
 - c. Pai Hao Tung Customhouse.
 - d. Yang O (羊額) inspection station in Shunte.
 - e. Canton Railway Station.

-  6. In early January Chinese Communist officials in Swatow were making money by aiding people who wish to escape from Swatow to Hong Kong or Macao. These officials charge HK \$1,000 or three ounces of gold to effect an escape, plus HK \$500 for hiring a fishing boat to smuggle people from the mainland.
