- 4. The director of the factory is Pulu Simionescu, whose salary is reportedly 280,000 led per month. The average worker earns between 4,000 and 6,000 led per month, depending on his output.
- 5. The production system is based on breaking up the work force into groups of sixteen. Cutting all eves shirt backs at retera, is the activity of all workers for a given time, averaging five or ten minutes.
- 6. Meetings of all the workers are held daily at Carol Park, renamed Parcul Liberal. These meetings are attended by high Rumanian Government officials such as Ana Pauker, Gheorghe Gheorghiu Dej, and others who give "pep" talks. Homen are told to work with all their might like their "brothers" are doing in Korea. A favorite theme is that production has to be stepped up in order to fight the Americans whose purpose is to destroy Rumanian workers.
