Between 26 and 28 December 1951, 15 jet fighters were parked in two rows along the taxiway near the flight control building at Brandenburg-Briest airfield. At 3 p.m. on 26 December, no flying was observed. Between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on 27 December, four jet fighters took off in groups of two and landed individually. Between 5 and 6 p.m. on 28 December, the noise of jet fighters flying at a high altitude above Brandenburg-Briest was heard. *

25X1A * [] Comment. Brandenburg-Briest airfield is still occupied by a jet fighter regiment. Flying observed on 27 and 28 December 1951 was also confirmed by []

25X1 [] The OATS of the regiment [] was last supplied with fuel from Velton fuel depot on 26 December 1951. 25X1C
