Prior to the end of December 1951, the Flak Kaserne on Luebschestrass, Wisnar (N 5h/J 49), was occupied to capacity. When the Soviet officers had to abandon their billets in private houses at the beginning of December, their orderlies said that they were assigned quarters in the attic of the barracks installation because the troop quarters were occupied to capacity. [redacted] the troops in the Flak Kaserne included infantrymen, because units with small arms and mortars were repeatedly seen marching. Artillerymen were believed to be there because motor vehicles towing artillery pieces were seen. A signal unit was believed there also because soldiers were seen practicing the stringing of telephone lines. In addition, [redacted] tanks entering or leaving the installation. [redacted] Some Russian women in uniform were also noticed in the billeting area. *

* [redacted] Comment. The report indicates that the Flak Kaserne still quarters components of the 208th Gds Itz Rifle Regt and the 199th Gds Gun Arty Regt, both of the 94th Gds Itz Rifle Div. [redacted] The tanks mentioned in the present report were probably used for training purposes by the infantry units in the Flak Kaserne. 25X1
