In September 1951 there were 10 new infantry companies of the Communist Coast Defense Bureau stationed in the area between Chritung (121-42, 31-49) and Lienyun (119-30, 34-45) Harbor. Officers of the Defense Bureau included Deputy Commander WANG Chrien (王 4)1, Political Commissar CHENG Wu-kuei (東京 1), 2 and Shipping Administrator HSU Pai-jung (京 白家). The companies were

- a. Three companies, commanded by CHIANG Chen-tung (將 振東), were in the harbor area of Lussuchen (121-38, 32-04).
- b. One company, commanded by WANG Chang-jung (王 長 梁), was in the harbor area of Jukao (120-33, 32-24) Hsien.
- c. One company, commanded by CHIANG I-ch'un (薑 一 春), was in the harbor area of Nanch'iang (120-51, 32-44).
- d. One company, commanded by MIU K'ai-chiu (試用九), was at Peich'iang (北茂) Harbor in Tungt'ai (120-18, 32-51) Hsien.
- e. Three guard companies, commanded by WEI I-tung (街,一長), a native of Kuanyun (119-18, 34-28), were in Hsink'ouyushih (新文浴室) and K'ueichiachien (農文文) in Yench'eng (120-09, 33-22) Hsien.

One company, commanded by CH'EN Chi-wen (東越文), was in the area around the mouth of the Sheyangho (120-, 33-).
