1. In January the Mawei (119-26, 25-59) Naval Shipyard was undergoing repairs.<sup>1</sup>
2. In mid-January the 32 Army was arriving in east and north Fukien.
3. In early February the Fukien Anti-Communist National Salvation Army gunboats YUCHE and TATUNG captured 4 Chinese Communist 40-ton junks and 2 other junks, south of Tungting (118-13, 24-10). The junks contained domestic letters, shipping documents, two tons of salt, three drums of tung oil, one drum of kerosene, one ton of clams and fertilizer, matches, potatoes, and beans.
