25X1 On 31 January 1952, about 25 twin-engine aircraft and probably 4 jet planes were observed at Altenburg airfield. No flying was observed at the field.

25X1 Except for patrols posted around the field, only a few personnel were observed.

25X1 Motor vehicles [redacted] were seen on the approach road north of the field.

25X1

[redacted] Comment. Altenburg airfield is occupied by an air transport regiment which is equipped with Li-2s. The number of aircraft previously observed varied between 24 and 35. The four MiG-15s were repeatedly observed at the field during 1951. It has not been determined whether the aircraft are assigned to fighter units or stationed at the field only temporarily. It is possible that an alert flight is permanently stationed at this airfield.
