1. Between 8 and 15 January 1952, there was no flying at Dessau airfield. On the morning of 15 January, about 50 Il-10s and 5 biplanes were parked on the southern edge of the field. Tank truck [redacted] with a trailer was also parked there. A closed truck [redacted] was observed in the yard of the barracks buildings. A hexagonal shaped superstructure was on top of the truck behind the driver's cabin. * A truck with a mounted searchlight was observed next to the radio installation on the southern edge of the field.

2. At 3:45 p.m. on 7 January, 42 Il-10s and 5 biplanes were counted on the southern edge of the field. [redacted] there was no flying. **

* [redacted] Comment. The vehicle is probably of the same type as the one which was previously reported from Berneuchen airfield. [redacted] Flying activity is probably controlled from this vehicle.

** [redacted] Comment. The field is still occupied by a ground attack regiment. [redacted]
