On 7 January 1952, Soviet purchasing engineer Palilov called at Zeiss, Jena, to inquire about the possibility of buying two Delta-type tachymeter-theodolites, stating that he needed them urgently. He was told that Zeiss was just beginning to set up production of these instruments, and that he could not expect delivery until early 1953. He was promised the first two instruments produced. Palilov stated that the official confirmation for this order would follow in writing. The cost price of these instruments will probably be about 4,000 DM each.

Comment: Since Palilov is the same engineer who concerns himself with the production of fine nickel wire screen in the DDR, it would seem reasonable to suspect that the above instruments are being purchased for the Soviet atomic energy authorities also.
